**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FEDERAL HEIGHTS,
COLORADO, IN REMEMBRANCE OF MAYOR DALE SPARKS**

WHEREAS, the City of Federal Heights was saddened by the passing of Dale Sparks on November 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Dale Sparks was elected as Mayor of Federal Heights in 1999; and

WHEREAS, Dale Sparks served as Chair of the Federal Heights Redevelopment Agency during his time as Mayor; and

WHEREAS, Dale Sparks was elected by voters to serve on the City's Home Rule Charter Commission in 2001, and selected by his peers to serve as chair of the commission; and

WHEREAS, Dale Sparks was re-elected as Mayor of Federal Heights in 2003; and

WHEREAS, Dale Sparks was elected to City Council, representing Ward I, in 2007; and

WHEREAS, Dale Sparks was appointed to serve on the Volunteer Firefighter Pension Board in 2016; and

WHEREAS, Dale Sparks was appointed to serve on the City's Board of Adjustment in 2016, was selected to serve as Chair by his peers, and served until his resignation in 2021; and


WHEREAS, Dale Sparks served on City Council when the City's drainage and stormwater utility enterprises were formed and when Safeway came to Federal Heights Marketplace at 104th Avenue and Federal Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, Dale Sparks participated in City events, especially enjoying Federal Heights Days; he promoted citizen involvement in local affairs and treatment for juvenile offenders; and transportation services for low-income and disabled residents. Dale was actively involved in local and national government organizations, and was proud of his service to the City.


