A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FEDERAL HEIGHTS, COLORADO, REAPPOINTING AMANDA L. BAILHACHE AS PRESIDING MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article 9 of the City's Home Rule Charter ("Charter") City Council is to appoint a presiding judge who shall serve for a term of two years; and

WHEREAS, City Council appointed Amanda L. Bailhache ("Bailhache") in January 2020 and reappointed her in January 2022 to serve as presiding municipal court judge for a term of two years; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to re-appoint Bailhache to serve as presiding municipal court judge for a two-year term from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Amanda L. Bailhache, shall continue to perform the duties of the presiding judge as set forth in Article 9 of the Charter and Colorado Revised Statutes, Article 10, Title 13 , for a fee to be established by ordinance, to be paid in monthly installments; and

WHEREAS, the City shall also pay Judge Bailhache's annual membership fees for the Colorado Municipal Judge's Association and all reasonable expenses for attending either the Association's annual conference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FEDERAL HEIGHTS, COLORADO THAT:

City Council does hereby appoint Amanda L. Bailhache to serve as the presiding judge of the Federal Heights Municipal Court for a two-year term commencing January 1, 2024, in accordance with all terms and conditions set forth above in the preamble which clauses are made a part of this resolution.


