Trees: Choose one tree from the options below. Make sure you have enough room for your tree to grow to its mature size. Consider overhead power lines, nearby structures, any adjacent curbs, sidewalks or poured concrete pads when choosing a location for your tree.



White Oak

(Quercus alba)

A stately, strong, and long-lived tree with beautiful dark red fall color, the White Oak is a great selection for yards. Best grown in rich, moist, acidic, well-drained loams in full sun. Adapts to a wide variety of soil conditions with good drought tolerance.

Max. Height: 50-80 feet

Max. Spread: 50-80 feet

Exposure: Full Sun

Water/Soil: Grows in well-drained soils, it prefers normal moisture, has good drought tolerance.

Green Giant Arborvitae

(Thuja standishii x plicata)

Green Giant Arborvitae can grow between three and six feet each year after the plant is properly established, making it one of the fastest-growing evergreens available on the market.

Max. Height: 20-40 feet

Max. Spread: 6-12 feet

Exposure: Full Sun

Needs regular but moderate watering; thrives in full sun or partial shade.

Indian Magic Crabapple

(*Malus x 'Indian Magic'*)

Four seasons of interest! Beautiful pink flowers emerge in spring followed by red berries on green foliage in the summer. The fall foliage is golden-orange. Persistent fruit turns glossy red in winter and provides fruit for winter birds that does not drop and make a mess.

Max. Height: 15 feet

Max. Spread: 15 feet

Exposure: Full Sun

Water/Soil: Moderate water needs, thrives in almost any soil condition.

Shrubs: Choose two shrubs that will thrive in the site you have in mind. Consider shade and sun needs and how large the plant will grow, whether it has thorns or not and what its seasonal characteristics are.



Royal Red Butterfly Bush

(*Buddleja davidii 'Royal Red'*)

Spectacular summer color from conical clusters of rich, purple-red flowers. The nectar-rich flowers have a splendid fragrance.

A good background or accent plant for a perennial border or cutting garden. Deciduous.

Max. Height: 6-8 feet

Max. Spread: 4-6 feet

Exposure: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Prefers well-drained, fertile soil. Water deeply, regularly during first growing season to establish extensive root system; reduce frequency once established.

Brick House® Rose

(Rosa x 'Meitraligh')

Brick House® is a compact Floribunda rose with a strong, dark red flower color and re-blooms throughout the season with a lot of flower power on each flush. It has excellent disease resistance for the type.

Max. Height: 3.5 feet

Max. Spread: 3.5 feet

Exposure: Full Sun

Water/Soil: Water needs moderate. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.



Brick House® Pink Rose

(Rosa x 'Sprogreatpink')

Brick House® Pink is a very compact Floribunda rose with fluorescent pink flowers that bloom continuously from spring through frost.

Max. Height: 3.5 feet

Max. Spread: 3.5 feet

Exposure: Full Sun

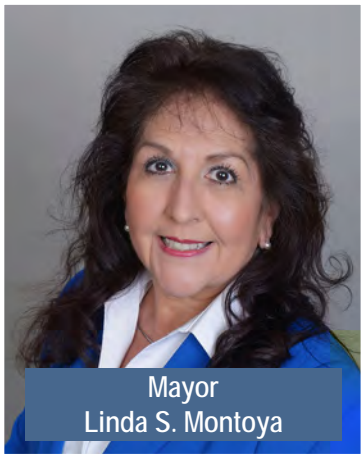
Water/Soil: Water needs moderate. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
